## Run-into Places

Places where people come together to meet, share ideas or local knowledge, relate to one another, get comfort and feel connected.

## Public Art

Interpret this as you want!  
Could be a mural or a sculpture, for example.

## Evidence of Ethnic Diversity

## Neighborhood Blight

An area that residents avoid because it is run down and perhaps perceived as unsafe.

## Street sign named after significant character in the community

## A place that holds significance to the local residents

## Gentrification

This is the process of renovating and improving a house or district so that it conforms to middle class taste.

## Uniqueness or Distinctiveness

Something that shows a local community as "being different" from other places.

## Place of Potential

A physical space that is not currently being used (or used well) that could be transformed by the local residents in such a way that it would add value to the neighborhood.

While walking around, be thinking, "In what ways might the uniqueness of this community bring opportunity for Gospel renewal?"
